EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3, SERIES 2024

**AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TERESA, RIZAL**

WHEREAS, as provided in Section 2. Declaration of Policy of Republic Act No. 9275 otherwise known as the "*Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004*", the "State shall pursue a policy of economic growth in a manner consistent with the protection, preservation and revival of the quality of our fresh, brackish and marine waters;

WHEREAS, Section 20 of the same law mandates local government units to share in the responsibility in the management and improvement of water quality within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" provides that "*local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them*";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODEL N. DELA CRUZ, Municipal Mayor of Teresa, Rizal by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation of the Liquid Waste Management Committee:

Section 1. Composition. The Liquid Waste Management Committee of Teresa, Rizal shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Powers and Functions. The Liquid Waste Management Committee shall perform the following:

- a. Assist in the drafting/crafting of Liquid Waste Management Plan for the Municipality of Teresa, Rizal;
- b. Formulate policies, plans, programs, and projects in relation to the preservation and conservation of bodies of water within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Teresa;
- c. Establish a cooperative effort in partnership with the relevant government agencies, academic institutions, civil society and the private sector to attain the objective of RA 9275;
- d. Disseminate information and conduct education awareness and value formation programs and campaigns on the effects of water pollution on health and environment, water quality management, and resource conservation and recovery to encourage an environmentally action-oriented society in coordination with government agencies identified in Section 22(f) of RA 9275;
- e. Promote and encourage private and business sectors especially manufacturing and processing plants the use of water quality management systems

- equipment, including but not limited to, industrial wastewater treatment collection and treatment facilities;
- f. Take active participation in all efforts concerning water quality protection and rehabilitation;
 - g. Ensure compliance with the framework of Water Quality Management Action Plan;
 - h. To coordinate with other government agencies and civil society and the concerned sectors in the implementation of measures to prevent and control water pollution;
 - i. Report, on an annual basis or as the need arises, to the relevant government agencies, the quality status of water bodies and other pertinent information and recommend possible legislation, policies and programs for environmental management and water pollution control;
 - j. Exercise such powers and perform such other functions as may be necessary to carry out the objectives of RA 9275.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorum. The Liquid Waste Management Committee shall meet at least once every quarter, or as often as may be necessary.

Section 4. Funding. The Municipal Government will provide operational funding and other necessary funds, subject to availability of its funds.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. All issuances, orders and memoranda issued inconsistent herewith are hereby nullified and/or repealed.

Section 6. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
