EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 6, SERIES OF 2024

AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL INVENTORY AND INSPECTION TEAM FOR MANILA BAY CLEAN-UP, REHABILITATION AND PREVENTION OF TERESA, RIZAL

WHEREAS, under the original order of the Supreme Court en banc, its directed all local government units (LGUs) in Metro Manila, Rizal, Laguna, Cavite, Bulacan, Pampanga, and Bataan to inspect all factories, commercial establishments, and private homes along the banks of major river systems and waterways that eventually discharge water to Manila Bay;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court also ordered concerned agencies to provide, install, operate and maintain the necessary adequate wastewater treatment facility in Metro Manila, Rizal, and Cavite, restore marine life; apprehend violators of existing laws designed to prevent marine pollution of Manila Bay; adopt measures to prevent dumping of solid and liquid wastes and other ship-generated wastes in Manila Bay's water from vessels; dismantle and remove all structures and constructions along the Pasig-Marikina-San Juan rivers, National Capital Region rivers, Navotas-Malabon-Tullahan-Tenejeros rivers, and other connection waterways and esteros in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, upon inventory of non-complying factories, commercial establishments and homes with laws, rules and regulations that require the construction or installation of wastewater treatment facilities and/or hygienic septic tank, the local government officials shall take appropriate action to ensure compliance;

WHEREAS, in the pursuit of a balance ecology and in an effort to restore Manila Bay, the local government authorities shall create Local Government Inventory and Inspection Team to monitor compliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, I, **RODEL N. DELA CRUZ**, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Teresa, Rizal, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Composition of the Municipal Inventory and Inspection Team for Manila Bay Clean-Up, Rehabilitation and Preservation. The Municipal Inventory and Inspection Team for Manila Bay Clean-Up, Rehabilitation and Preservation shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Duties and Functions of the Municipal Inventory and Inspection Team for Manila Bay Clean-Up, Rehabilitation and Preservation. The Municipal Inventory and Inspection Team for Manila Bay Clean-Up, Rehabilitation and Preservation shall have the following functions:

- (a) Conduct inspection and inventory of all factories, commercial establishment, and private homes within and outside the easement along shorelines and banks of major and minor river systems and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Teresa, Rizal;
- (b) Monitor the compliance of non-complying factories, commercial establishments and private homes along shorelines and banks of major and minor river systems and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Teresa, Rizal;
- (c) Recommend the imposition of necessary sanctions of penalties to the Local Chief Executive of all non-complying factories, commercial establishments and private homes along shorelines and banks of major and minor river systems and waterways within the Manila Bay Wastershed Area under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Teresa, Rizal;
- (d) Prepare and submit the following Manila Bayanihan reports once every quarter;

Quarterly reports shall be submitted every 5th of the ensuing month after the end of the quarter.

(e) Perform other task that maybe assigned from time to time relative to the implementation of the Manila Bay Clean Up Rehabilitation and Preservation Project;

The Team shall meet at least once a month or as often as may be necessary.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All issuances, orders and memoranda issued inconsistent herewith are hereby nullified and/or repealed.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
