MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 17, S. 2022

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF CASH CARDS ISSUED TO HOUSEHOLD BENEFICIARIES OF THE PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM (4Ps) AS COLLATERAL OF A LOAN PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 Basic Services and Facilities of Republic Act (R.A) 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "...local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) is a flagship program of the national government on poverty reduction and social development. It is one of the responses of

the Philippine Government the challenge of meeting the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs);

WHEREAS, the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) is a human development measure of government that provides cash grants to the poorest of the poor, to improve the health, nutrition and the education of children of the household beneficiaries aged 0-18;

WHEREAS, through the crafting of this Sangguniang Bayan Ordinance, there will be not only protection in the interest of the household beneficiaries from unscrupulous individuals or entities of unlawful machinations but also preservation in the integrity of the program;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained-by the Sangguniang Bayan of Teresa, Rizal in session assembled to enact:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and cited as "Cash Grant Protection Act of 2022".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

- 2.1 It is hereby declared the policy of the municipality to promote the general welfare of its inhabitants;
- 2.2It is likewise the policy of the municipality to protect its inhabitants from deceitful machinations perpetrated by unscrupulous individuals or entity; and
- 2.3 It also the policy of the municipality to help the national government in weeding-out undesirable household beneficiaries from the program

SECTION 3. COVERAGE.

- Individuals offering loan to household beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) requiring cash cards as collateral;
- 3.2 Officers or Agents of entities like associations, cooperatives, companies, or corporations offering loan to household beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program or 4Ps requiring Cash Cards as collateral; and
- 3.3 All household beneficiaries of the program including those families in the modified cash transfer program in need of special protection as follows:
 - 3.3.1 street families;
 - 3.3.2 itinerant indigenous families;
 - 3.3.3 families displaced by natural and manmade disasters;
 - 3.3.4 families with a person with disability (PWD);
 - 3.3.5 child laborers;
 - 3.3.6 children in conflict with the law;
 - 3.3.7 families with members with terminal disease; and
 - 3.3.8 victim of human trafficking.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITED ACTS.

- 4.1 It shall be unlawful for any individual mentioned in Section III (a), officers or agents of entities like associations, cooperatives, companies, or corporations with or without juridical personality to offer loan to household beneficiaries mentioned in Section III (b) requiring Cash Cards as collateral; and
- 4.2 It shall be unlawful for any household beneficiaries or any member of the families mentioned in Section III (c) to use their CASH CARD as collateral of a loan.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES.

- 5.1 For persons mentioned in Section IV (a), a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00) or an imprisonment of two (2) months or both in the discretion of the court shall be imposed for the violation of this Ordinance; and
- 5.2 For household beneficiaries or any members mentioned in Section III, a fine of One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) or an imprisonment of two (2) months or both in the discretion of the court shall be imposed for the violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENATING RULES AND REGULATIONS.

The Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office is hereby mandated to formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of this Ordinance for its efficient and effective implementation within sixty (6) days after its effectivity.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE

Any Ordinance or Executive Orders, Proclamations and Administrative Regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If, for any reason a portion or portions of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the other provisions not affected thereby, pursuant to the provisions of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

This Ordinance shall take effect after posting in Three (3) conspicuous places in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.
